Open Public Meetings Act

Meeting called for the following purpose:

To receive input from the public to assist the Governing Body in identifying problems with the on street parking of vehicles, particularly within the residential neighborhoods of our City.

A subcommittee of City Council comprised of Council President McGuigan, Councilman Dill and Councilman Triboletti has been designated to analyze the problem, gather data, examine alternative solutions and prepare a report with recommendations to City Council for consideration.

The goal of city Council is to provide a manageable solution to this long standing problem which has affected the City. The intent is to create a City wide Parking Plan for the health, safety and welfare of our residents while adequately accommodating our valued visitors and non-resident employees who work in our community businesses.

The City Council and the subcommittee will examine a variety of alternatives including but not limited to: 1) expanding No Parking/No stopping zones; ii) creating zones with restricted parking hours; iii) creating zones with parking time limits; iv) paid municipal parking lots; v) installation of parking meters in certain zones; vi) procedures for implementing Parking by Permit only in certain neighborhoods; and vii) enhanced enforcement procedures.
