

Spray Message

“Weather permitting, the Atlantic County Office of Mosquito Control plans to treat **parts of Linwood and Somers Point**, as part of its ongoing effort to control adult mosquitoes.

“In Linwood and Somers Point, spraying to reduce adult mosquitoes using ground application equipment will take place on Thursday morning September 4th, between 4:30am and 6:00 am. The areas to be treated are bounded by Kirklin Ave., Wabash Ave., Kirklin Ave., Berkeley St., Seagarden Dr., East Royal Ave., Ocean Heights Ave., Shore Rd., Ocean Ave., Bay Ave., Pierson Ave., Bethel Rd., and New Rd.

*Ground spraying will be done using **Zenivex E4 RTU**, the trade name for **etofenprox**, applied as an ultra low volume aerosol.”*

The EPA does not require relocating or taking special precautions during mosquito control spraying, but people may choose to avoid or minimize exposure by:

- Staying indoors during application to their immediate area
- Keeping windows shut, window fans and air conditioners off (or set to circulate indoor air) during spraying
- Keeping children’s toys indoors
- Keeping pets indoors, as well as their food, water dishes and toys.
