- 3. Utilizing themes and eliciting feedback from students
- 4. Assisting in displaying completed artwork

- 3. Visual Arts experience, especially as it relates to the position for grades 4-8
- 4. Describe in sufficient detail an example of your proposed arts project (can be one big project that continues for the 8-days or several smaller ones) and the materials required that you may want to use.
- 5. References that include the names and contact information of persons who can verify experience.
- 6. Proof of fingerprint background check (please let us know if you need assistance in acquiring)
- 7. Completion of a survey provided by the SPAC for satisfying grant requirements.

ART INSTRUCTOR COMPENSATION

The salary for this part time, seasonal position is:

\$30/hr. for direct instruction at the Summer Art Camp (eight, two-hour sessions) An additional \$100 for general prep, planning and purchasing of materials (materials will be reimbursed)

COMPENSATION PAYMENT PROCEDURE

Payment to the art instructor will be made after the submission of a timesheet for both instructional and planning hours sent to the Financial Office every 2 weeks based on the deadlines provided by the Somers Point Finance Office and after a signed approval by the SPAC Chair or designee.

Payments for purchased supplies will be paid directly to the supplier/vendor by the SPAC with signed Purchase Order by the vendor supplier or by reimbursement to the arts instructor upon presentation of receipts.

Qualified applicants who wish to respond to this request shall submit one (1) copy of their application package in an envelope clearly marked "Application for Summer Art Instructor". Applications shall be received by mail or in
